REGISTRATION WILL BE MADE UNLESS YOUR CLASS IS CANCELLED.

Be sure to note the beginning time and ending time of your child's classes. **classes are 55 minutes long**, leaving 5 minutes for changing classes and teacher preparation.

➤ ADMISSION

Classes are open to all public, private, and parochial school children. Pre-school children must be 4 years of age before Oct. 1, 2023 in order to register.

➤ EMERGENCY

➤ FEES & REFUNDS

Material fees for certain courses are included in course fee. Checks should be made payable to **Saturday Happening**. Refunds will be made in the event of insufficient class enrollment and/or other administrative reasons. **No refunds will be made after the first class.** The Saturday Happening reserves the right to limit enrollment or cancel a class. **Refunds include a \$10.00 processing fee except for cancellations.**

Parents who transport children must be certain to arrange for prompt arrival and departure. Parents are required to remain out of the classroom beyond the start of class. Children should use the Prospect Ave entrance. Parents should be aware that crossing guards will not be on duty. A parent waiting room is provided.
