REGISTRATION WILL BE MADE UNLESS YOUR CLASS IS CANCELLED.

Be sure to note the beginning time and ending time of your child's classes. **classes are 55 minutes long**, leaving 5 minutes for changing classes and teacher preparation.

➤ ADMISSION

Classes are open to all public, private, and parochial school children. Pre-school children must be 4 years of age before Oct. 1, 2020 in order to register.

➤ EMERGENCY

In case of emergency during Saturday school hours only email bsansanelli@ridgefieldschools.com or call (201) 945-4455 to reach Saturday Happening personnel. If emergency medical treatment is required, the director will use judgement in sending your child to the hospital or doctor most assessable. If you oppose this viewpoint, please indicate to us in writing. No written indication will be viewed as your compliance.

➤ FEES & REFUNDS

Material fees for certain courses are included in course fee. Checks should be made payable to **Saturday Happening**. Refunds will be made in the event of insufficient class enrollment and/or other administrative reasons. **No refunds will be made after the first class.** The Saturday Happening reserves the right to limit enrollment or cancel a class. **Refunds include a \$10.00 processing fee except for cancellations.**

➤ *TRANSPORTATION*

Parents who transport children must be certain to arrange for prompt arrival and departure. Parents of children needing an escort to rooms between classes must remain to provide that escort for their own children. **NO ESCORT SERVICE WILL BE PROVIDED.** Parents are required to remain out of the classroom beyond the start of class. Children should use the Walnut street entrance. Parents should be aware that crossing guards will not be on duty. A parent waiting room is provided.

➤ EXCLUSION

The Saturday Happening Director reserves the right to refuse registration or to remove any child from class for disciplinary reasons.

You will receive a phone call in case of an emergency closing.

COVID-19 Guidelines for outdoor classes:

- Students and instructors will first have their temperature checked before entering the play field/court.
- Students, instructors, and parents will adhere to social distancing.
- Instructors will wear a mask at all times.
- The students must wear a mask until they enter the field/court.
- Students may remove their masks on the field/court (as we will be keeping social distancing or keep it on if they would prefer).
- Parents will be asked to keep a 6ft social distance from others while waiting and would be allowed to bring their own chair if they would like to sit while they wait.

***Due to these guidelines we must keep our classes no more than 10 students and no more than 6 for tennis. Please act fast as these may fill up quickly!**
